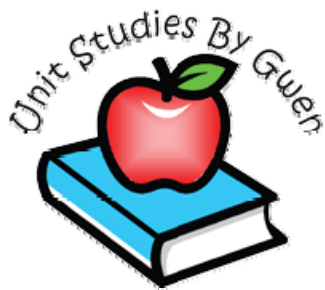

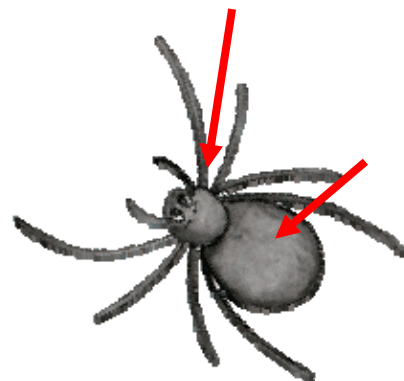

Spiders kill other animals to eat.

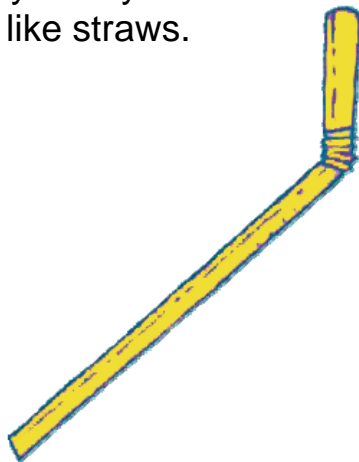
Some spiders catch their dinner in webs.

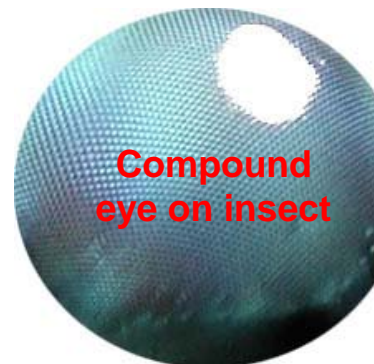
Spiders can use silk to:
